- The Free State / Liberty Alliance agenda is backed by millions in out-of-state funding from the Koch family's Americans For Prosperity, Young Americans for Liberty, the American Legislative Exchange Council and others.

- The NH Republican Party is now run by the Free State Project and Liberty Alliance. Gov. Kelly Ayotte was on the board of Blackstone, a backer of the Free State agenda. House Majority leader Jason Osborne is a Free Stater.
